

You are **selling goods in Germany**. Great!

But how to comply with EPR rules?

Are you the first to bring the products on the German market in consumer packaging?

Yes!

You need to comply with VerpackG

Register with Verpackungsregister (LUCID)

Register with a **take-back scheme**, such as Reclay

Report your packaging volumes subject to system participation* and **pay your fees** to the take-back system

File a report with the declared packaging quantities to LUCID

Repeat periodically

! Almost everyone needs to comply with the packaging act.

The take-back system handles the actual recycling

*Every packaging that falls under system participation. Some types of packaging aren't included yet, but this can change.

What products do you sell?

chargeable electronic products

Containing batteries and/or accumulator(s)

You need to comply with WEEE

Check what WEEE categories your products fall under to see which WEEE registrations are **necessary**

Register your brand with the right category at Stiftung EAR

Report your quantities monthly to your AR and pay your fees

Repeat periodically

You need to comply with BATG

Join a take-back scheme, such as ÖcoReCell

Create an account & register your brand with the right category at Stiftung EAR

Wait for take back scheme confirmation before you can **submit registration**

Submit registration

File your quantities as your take-back scheme requires (this may vary)

! It depends on the products you sell if you need to comply with the WEEE and/or BATG

This can only be done by an authorized representative

Find authorized representative (AR)
